Job-Embedded Professional Development & Collaboration

Teachers collaborate regularly to:

- Review and analyze assessment data to identify trends, strengths, and needs.
- Set measurable student achievement goals at each grade level.
- Engage in differentiated professional development tailored to classroom data.
- Participate in structured sessions for lesson planning, intervention design, and strategy sharing.
- Reflect on instructional practices and student outcomes for continuous improvement.
- Receive coaching and co-teaching support from instructional coaches and literacy specialists.

Measurable Student Achievement Goals

- **Kindergarten:** 90% identify all letters (uppercase/lowercase) and master letter-sound correspondences.
- Grade 1: 85% read grade-level texts fluently (60-80 wpm, 95% accuracy).
- **Grade 2:** 80% comprehend grade-level texts, answering literal/inferential questions with 80% accuracy.
- **Grade 3:** 85% read grade-level texts fluently (95% accuracy) and show comprehension through summaries or higher-order questions 4/5 times.
- **Grade 4:** 80% identify text structures, main ideas, supporting details, and cite evidence with 75–80% accuracy.
- **Grade 5:** 85% analyze and interpret texts, compare/contrast themes, and provide evidence with 80% accuracy.

End-of-unit benchmarks assess **MyView Literacy** Foundational & comprehension skills masterv. **STAR** Phonics, fluency, vocabulary, Given 3x/year; provides data for comprehension interventions and individualized (Accelerated Reader) learning paths. **IREAD** Foundational & Used in grades 2–3 for summative comprehension skills evaluation and placement in interventions.

MyView Literacy	Vocabulary, comprehension	End-of-unit benchmarks.
IREAD	Vocabulary, comprehension	Summative for grades 2–3; determines intervention placement.

Literacy Interventions

- Grade 2 ("At Risk" on IREAD) & Grade 3 ("Did Not Pass" IREAD):
 - Small-group instruction (phonics, fluency, comprehension).
 - Direct instruction in retelling, sequencing, and text-dependent questions.
 - Year-long interventions plus summer programming.
- Grades 4+ ("Did Not Pass" IREAD):
 - o Continued small-group phonics, fluency, comprehension.
 - o Direct instruction aligned to science of reading.
 - Ongoing support until passing score or entry into grade 7.

Attendance & Instructional Time

- Dedicated Reading Block: Not required (school maintains 90%+ passing on IREAD).
- Summer Program: Offered for grade 2 "At Risk" and grade 3 "Did Not Pass" students.
